



§ 1 Subject of Agreement

- Subject of agreement is the publication of two articles in the extent of about 60 pages, where the copyright lies by the Author, in a scientific print work. The article have the titles "Chapter 1: Introduction and Summary" and "Annex 8: Statistical Background: Testing for trends and change points (jumps)".
- The title of the scientific print work is "Assessment of Climate Change for the Baltic Sea Basin". The Editor has assigned his employee Prof. Hans von Storch with the realisation of the publication.
- The print work will be implemented in the publishing house Springer-Verlag GmbH Berlin Heidelberg - hereinafter called Springer-Verlag -.

§ 2 Concession of Rights of Use

- The Author grants the Editor the following rights of use. He/she agrees that these rights shall be granted to the Springer-Verlag as well. These are the rights to copy and distribute in print and any medium such as in its electronic form (offline, online), as well to translate, print, publish, distribute and sell in any foreign languages and throughout the world.
- The Author confirms the Editor that he/she has the sole copyright on his/her article, and that he/she has not assigned this right otherwise in full or in part.

§ 3 Legal Harmlessness

- The Author affirms, that his/her article as well as text and illustration of foreign origin does not hurt third parties rights and that he/she is authorised to use them for the purpose of this scientific print work.
- Should the Author for legal reasons be unable to give the aforementioned affirmation or becomes doubts whether he/she might do so, he/she shall immediately inform the Editor.
