



An open Baltic Earth PhD seminar in connection to the Gulf of Finland Final Scientific Forum

Exchange processes between the Gulf of Finland and other Baltic Sea basins

Tallinn, Estonia, 19 November 2015

This open PhD seminar focuses on interactions between the Gulf of Finland with the Baltic Sea, including meteorological, oceanographical and hydrological process descriptions. The seminar is intended primarily for PhD students and is attached to the Gulf of Finland Forum.

Key note lectures:

- Physical-Biogeochemical modelling of the Baltic Sea- Gulf of Finland, fluxes between the basins (H.E. Markus Meier, SMHI, Sweden)
- Specific effects of climate change on the Gulf's ecosystem (Markku Viitasalo, SYKE, Finland)
- The Major Baltic Inflow 2014: Description and ecosystem processes (Günther Nausch, IOW, Germany)
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Call for papers for PhD students working on Gulf of Finland topics

Students are invited to submit an abstract of their presentation which should be based on their PhD theses related to the Gulf of Finland and the above mentioned topics. Oral/poster presentations will be selected based on the submitted abstracts. The best student presentation is honored with a GoF prize.

Participants with selected oral/poster presentations may send manuscripts to a Special issue of the Journal of Marine Systems.
